36	(b) It is the	intent of the General Assembly to assist	st consumers by

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1	providing them the information and tools necessary to be informed and
2	educated consumers of insurance coverage.
3	
4	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 23-67-218, concerning records and reports
5	used in the regulation of insurance rates, is amended to add an additional
6	subsection to read as follows:
7	(c) The commissioner may review the rates and other information
8	gathered, compiled, and reported to the commissioner from the Arkansas Fire
9	Rating Bureau under the Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau Act, § 23-67-701 et seq.
10	
11	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 23, Chapter 67, is amended to add an
12	additional subchapter to read as follows:
13	<u>Subchapter 7 — Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau Act</u>
14	
15	<u>23-67-701. Title.</u>
16	This subchapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Arkansas Fire
17	Rating Bureau Act".
18	
19	23-67-702. Definitions.
20	As used in this subchapter:
21	(1) "Insurer" means:
22	(A) An entity that provides fire insurance in this state,
23	including without limitation an insurance company; or
24	(B) A person, firm, association, corporation, or any other
25	entity operating a property and casualty insurance business providing fire
26	insurance benefits subject to state insurance regulation; and
27	(2) "User fees" means the amount an insurer is responsible for
28	as the insurer's proportion of the expenses for the organization,
29	maintenance, and operation of the Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau.
30	
31	23-67-703. Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau — Creation — Organization.
32	(a) There is created a legal entity to be known as the "Arkansas Fire
33	Rating Bureau".
34	(b)(1) The bureau may organize and operate as a corporation,
35	association, or a limited partnership and provide for any officers, board of
36	directors, and bylaws as necessary.

1	(2)(A) Except to the extent provided by this subchapter, the
2	bureau is exempt from the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et
3	seq.
4	(B) The bureau shall adopt policies, procedures, and rules
5	to implement its obligations under this subchapter pursuant to the Arkansas
6	Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq.
7	(c)(1) Beginning January 1, 2018, an insurer may become a member of
8	the bureau.
9	(2) Each insurer that is a member of the bureau shall pay the
10	insurer's proportion of the expenses for the organization, maintenance, and
11	operation of the bureau.
12	(d) The bureau shall employ residents of this state who are skilled in
13	the business of:
14	(1) Fire insurance rating;
15	(2) Fire hazard;
16	(3) Fire protection engineering; and
17	(4) Fire insurance inspection.
18	
19	<u>23-67-704. Participation in Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau — Expenses —</u>
20	Operations.
21	(a) An insurer may be a member of the Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau.
22	(b)(1) The expense for the organization, maintenance, and operation of
23	the bureau shall be paid by the members of the bureau through assessment of
24	user fees and annual assessments.
25	(2) A bureau member shall pay user fees that include the bureau
26	member's proportion of the expenses of organization, maintenance, and
27	operation of the bureau as provided under this section and § 23-67-703.
28	(3) Expenses for the bureau shall not be paid by the state or
29	any county or municipality in this state.
30	(c) An expense of the bureau that is not covered by user fees shall be
31	shared by all bureau members through an annual assessment as established by
32	the bureau with due consideration given to the extent of utilization of the
33	services of the bureau.
34	(d)(1) If a bureau member does not pay its proportion of the expense
35	within thirty (30) days after the amount is due, the bureau may refuse to
36	furnish services of the bureau to the delinquent bureau member.

1	(2) The bureau shall report the delinquency of the bureau member		
2	to the Insurance Commissioner, who for the delinquency may suspend or revoke		
3	the license of the delinquent bureau member.		
4	(e) The bureau shall establish reasonable fees for any service offered		
5	by the bureau that is sufficient to maintain and operate the bureau under		
6	this subchapter.		
7	(f) As a condition of being a member of the bureau, an insurer shall		
8	pay the user fees and assessments, submit the reports, and provide the		
9	information required by the commissioner to implement this subchapter.		
10			
11	23-67-705. Failure to comply — Penalties under the Arkansas Insurance		
12	Code applicable.		
13	If an insurer that is a member of the Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau		
14	refuses or neglects to comply with this subchapter or with any order or		
15	ruling made by the Insurance Commissioner under this subchapter, the bureau		
16	member is subject to any penalties under the Arkansas Insurance Code.		
17			
18	23-67-706. User fees and assessments.		
19	The Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau shall collect user fees and assessments		
20	from insurers that are members of the bureau that are sufficient to enable		
21	the bureau to:		
22	(1) Inspect every risk specially rated;		
23	(2) Make a written survey of the risks specially rated;		
24	(3) Pay the salary or expense of its officers and employees; and		
25	(4) Cover any other expense that may be necessary to enable the		
26	bureau to comply with and enforce this subchapter.		
27			
28	23-67-707. Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau — Requirement to inspect every		
29	risk rated.		
30	(a) The Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau, through bureau members and		
31	employees, shall inspect every risk specifically rated by it on schedule and		
32	make a written survey of the risk that shall be filed as a permanent record		
33	in the bureau.		
34	(b) A copy of the written survey shall be furnished to an owner or the		
35	Insurance Commissioner upon request.

1	23-67-708. Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau — Agreement for placing
2	insurance prohibited.
3	The Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau, or any of its officers or employees,
4	shall not make a contract or agreement with any person, insurer, or insured,
5	that fire insurance shall be written or placed with a particular insurer.
6	
7	23-67-709. Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau — Required information.
8	(a) The Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau is required to provide any
9	information requested by the Insurance Commissioner concerning the bureau's
10	organization, maintenance, operation, or any other matter connected with
11	transactions of the bureau.
12	(b) The commissioner may require that the bureau provide any
13	information the commissioner deems necessary.
14	
15	23-67-710. Examination of Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau — Reports.
16	(a) The Insurance Commissioner shall have the power to examine the
17	Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau as often as the commissioner deems necessary at
18	the expense of the bureau.
19	(b) The commissioner shall:
20	(1) Report his or her findings in writing;
21	(2) Include his or her findings as part of the annual report
22	required under § 23-63-216; and
23	(3) Provide a copy of the report described in subdivision (b)(1)
24	of this section to the Attorney General.
25	
26	23-67-711. Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau — Rate discrimination
27	prohibited.
28	The Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau is prohibited from recommending any
29	rate for fire insurance on property in this state that:
30	(1) Discriminates against the same territorial classification
31	between risks in the application of similar charges and credits; or
32	(2) Discriminates unfairly between risks of essentially the same
33	hazard and having substantially the same degree of protection against fire.
34	
35	23-67-712. Factors to be considered when rating fire district —
36	Determination of overall fire rating.

1	(a) when fatting a municipality of fife district, including evaluations	
2	of a rural or volunteer fire department, the Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau	
3	shall consider the mileage, condition, and maintenance of the fire trucks	
4	rather than the age of the fire trucks.	
5	(b)(l) For the purpose of grading municipalities or fire districts,	
6	including rural and volunteer fire departments, and awarding credits that are	
7	considered in determining an overall fire rating based on the condition of	
8	fire trucks of a municipality or fire district, including a rural and	
9	volunteer fire department, the bureau shall publish guidelines for use in the	
10	grading of fire trucks on or before January 30 of each calendar year that the	
11	bureau will apply the guidelines.	
12	(2)(A) The guidelines described in subdivision (b)(1) of this	
13	section shall be published and made available to each municipality and fire	
14	district, including rural and volunteer fire departments, on the bureau's	
15	website no later than January 30 of the calendar year during which the bureau	
16	will apply the guidelines.	
17	(B) If a fire truck in a municipality or fire district,	
18	including a rural and volunteer fire department, satisfies the guidelines	
19	under subdivision (b)(1) of this section, then the bureau shall not recommend	
20	the replacement of the fire truck before the next grading process.	
21		
22	23-67-713. Rules.	
23	The Insurance Commissioner shall promulgate rules to implement this	
24	subchapter.	
25		
26	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 23-88-104 is amended to read as follows:	
27	23-88-104. Fire protection to be considered in property insurance	
28	rating plans.	
29	When making a rate or rule filing, an insurer shall include an impact	
30	statement concerning the filing's effect on fire protection in the affected	
31	area unless the insurer utilizes a public protection classification system	
32	maintained by a licensed advisory organization or the Arkansas Fire Rating	
33	Bureau under the Arkansas Fire Rating Bureau Act, § 23-67-701 et seq.	
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
